Jehovah Jireh-Our Provider

Jehovah: *the Eternal, Self-Existent One, Who changes not, and reveals Himself to us.*

Jireh: *The God Who desires to meet our needs, our hopes, our dreams, and abundantly supply more than we can ask or think!*

Through Jesus, God provides our needs, and our desires. He wants to lavish us with goodness, both good things (materially) and good things (for our hearts and souls). He gives us food, guidance, protection, abundance, seed to sow, peace, favor, faith, honor, power, strength, joy, love, and life. Our Father in heaven is more than our Everlasting Father, He is "Daddy," and our best Friend, He's El Shaddai, He's Jehovah Jireh, our provider. He has provided ahead of time for the very best of everything we could ever hope for. He loves us with a never-ending love, and he loves us all the same-equally! He is wonderful!

A. Definitions/ Strong's and 1828, Noah Webster

1. Provision: Strong's 7200 (Hebrew) **Ra'ah:** **"To see", both direct and implied. Total vision before, present, ahead of time.** 1. **Genesis 22:8** *God will provide, himself a lamb.* 2. **I Kings 4:7, 27,** **which provides victuals for the king and his..., provided victuals for King Solomon.** Strong's 4265 (Greek) **Problepo:** **To look out beforehand, to furnish in advance.** **Hebrews 11:40** *God having provided for some better thing...* Strong's 4306 (Greek) **Proneos:** **To consider in advance, to look out beforehand.** 1. **I Timothy 5:8** *But if any provide not for his own, and ...*

2. Provision: 1828 Noah Webster's

a. The act of providing or making previous preparation.

b. Things provided, preparation, measures taken before hand either for security, defense, attack or for the supply of wants. We make provision to defend ourselves from enemies; for war; to serve a meal; for a voyage; for the erecting of a building; for the support of the poor, for the well-being of our loved ones in the future. Stores provided; stock; as provision of victuals (pronounced "vit'ls"); food; all manner of edibles for table, family or an army.

c. Victuals: **A noun (pronounced vit'ls). Completely prepared food. To supply w/provisions food for human beings, prepared for eating; that which supports human life; meat, sustenance (never applied to that which animals eat). It is food cooked and prepared for the table. Name does not apply to unprepared food only well cooked and dressed and food in great abundance.**

A victualing house: **A house where provision is made for strangers to eat.**

3. Prosper/Prosperous/Prosperity: Strong's

a. To be successful; to succeed. The state of being successful. To grow or increase; to thrive; to make gain; favored, or favorable; rendering successful; advancing in growth, wealth, or any good, attainment of the object desired.

4. Rich/Richness: 1828 Noah Webster

a. Abundant in materials; yielding great qualities of anything valuable; as a rich mine. Abounding in valuable ingredients or qualities; as a rich odor or flavor; rich spices.

b. Full; fertile; fruitful; abundant; plentifully stocked; strong; vivid; having something precious; highly seasoned; as rich paste; a rich dish of food; abounding with a variety of delicious food; containing abundance beyond wants; as a rich treasury; highly endowed w/ spiritual gifts.

c. Opulence; wealth; finery; splendor; of high seasoning; or whatever constitutes perfection; of bright imagery or of striking ideas.

5. Blessing/Bless/Blessed: 1828 Noah Webster

a. To praise; to glorify. Benediction or pronouncement of happiness, fulfillment and/or success to one, a gift of favor, to invoke peace, plenty, health. Any means of happiness; a gift, benefit or advantage; that which promotes temporal prosperity and welfare or immortal felicity.

b. To set apart or consecrate to holy purposes; to make or pronounce holy. To consecrate by prayer; to invoke a blessing upon.

6. Favor/Favored: Strong's: Luke 1:28, 30, Luke 2:52 Charitoo (Greek) To grace, endue with special honor – make accepted. Daniel 1:4, preferential treatment, honor and glory given as a gift out of good.

Favor/Favored: 1828 Noah Webster

a. To regard with kindness; to support; to aid or have the disposition to aid or to wish success to; to be propitious to; to countenance; to befriend; to encourage; by means of aid, counsel, or by active exertions; to facilitate. A person or thing regarded with peculiar favor, esteem, preference and affection; one greatly beloved.

b. To resemble in features, a child who favors his parents.

Could it be that through knowledge of our covenant, and revelation of Jesus' Almighty contract of love, we can tap into and take hold of all that Jesus did for us when he lived, died, was resurrected from this earth in victory, and ascended into heaven to sit at God's right hand to ever intercede for us?
